THE INTERNATIONAL SPACE STATION (ISS) WAS LAUNCHED IN 1998 AND IS THE TENTH SPACE STATION HUMANS HAVE PUT IN TO ORBIT!

THE ISS WAS CREATED AND PAID FOR BY 16 DIFFERENT COUNTRIES. IT IS THE SINGLE MOST EXPENSIVE OBJECT EVER BUILT, COSTING AROUND £85BILLION!



TRAVELLING AT A SPEED OF 5 MILES EVERY SECOND, THE ISS TAKES JUST 90 MINUTES TO ORBIT THE EARTH. ASTRONAUTS SEE 15 SUNRISES OR SUNSETS EVERY DAY!

DUE TO THE EFFECTS OF WEIGHTLESSNESS ASTRONAUTS HAVE TO EXERCISE FOR AT LEAST TWO HOURS EVERY DAY TO KEEP FIT. FORTUNATELY THERE'S A GYM ON BOARD - GOING FOR A RUN IN SPACE IS RATHER DIFFICULT!
